Checklist: Documents Required from the Applicant for Consideration for a Scholarship

1. Completed application
2. Proof of enrollment in school or program
3. Proof of expense (may include an invoice from the school, or an official letter from the school or vendor stating expenses)
4. Signed Release of Information Form
5. Signed Recipient of Scholarship Funds Agreement (will be supplied to applicant for signature if scholarship is awarded)
6. Two (2) Page Essay - Stating goals and long term academic plan. Must be double spaced and have 1 inch margins
7. Proof of research of other funds
8. Completed FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
9. Letter of Recommendation - cannot have been written by a Snoqualmie Tribal Citizen, family member, or Tribal employee/representative
10. Name and contact information (phone and email address) for at least two (2) references
11. Meeting with Scholarship Administrator (can be done over the phone if student is not in local area)
12. W9 W9 from School or Vendor (this document provides the Tribe with the vendor's tax id number and is a standard form. If the vendor does not have a W9 on hand they may find one on the internet)
