



Snoqualmie Tribe Health Services

Welcome to Snoqualmie Contract Health. You are eligible for Direct Care Services only through the Snoqualmie Tribal Health clinics. This is a federally funded program through Indian Health Service in partnership with Snoqualmie Tribe. You are eligible because you are American Indian or Alaska Native and have provided proof of tribal membership or affiliation with a federally recognized tribe and are residing within the Snoqualmie CHS service area. (See “Users Guide to CHS” for more details on eligibility for direct care services.)

Direct care services are limited to patient care provided by staff within the North Bend Family Clinic or Tolt Family Clinic (see contact information below). These services will be provided at no cost to you. Your insurance, if any, will be billed and remaining balances and/or co-pays are waived.

Examples of services provided at the clinics include: family and primary health care, pediatric care, physical exams, well child visits, immunizations, diabetes care, other chronic disease management, minor surgical procedures, urgent care visits, and mental health or chemical dependency counseling.

Coverage is limited to services provided within our clinic facilities. It does not include Indirect Care CHS coverage. Examples of services not covered are: labs sent outside the clinics for processing, medications and other pharmaceutical supplies, specialty services, prenatal care, x-rays and other imaging, emergency and/or hospital care.
