

Apartment Available for Snoqualmie Tribal Members

The Housing Committee of the Snoqualmie Tribe announces an apartment available to rent to a Snoqualmie Tribal household.

The apartment is a small studio located up a flight of stairs on the 2nd floor of the Tribe's Raging River Recovery Program on Boalch Avenue in North Bend.

Because of its location above a sensitive tribal program – one that holds meetings in the evenings during weekdays – the Committee is placing restrictions on the type of family who can rent the apartment.

Only people who meet the following requirements will be considered to rent the apartment –

- one or two persons maximum, with no child under 14 years old
- no alcohol or illegal drug use whatsoever – zero tolerance because of the apartment's location above a sensitive program
- no one who has been a client of the Raging River Program in the last 2 years
- mature and stable people who will respect the confidentiality of anyone they may see attending the program
- extremely quiet people, who will not make any loud noises or have loud volume on a television or other audio equipment
- very responsible people, with proven stable income, who will be able to pay their rent on time and keep the apartment clean
- no more than one car for an adult & child, or two cars for two adults

The rent will be based on the total household income, and will be charged at one-third (1/3) of the total net (after taxes) household income. The lease will be for 6 months to begin, and then month-to-month for the possibility that the RR Program might expand and need the apartment for program space.

Applications must be filled-out completely, signed, dated & received by the Housing Director by **April 30, 2009**. Applications may be mailed to the address below, or faxed to 206.350.4698, or e-mailed to the Housing Director at jamie@snoqualmiation.com.

The Committee will review the applications, may decide to interview anyone it chooses, may decide to reject all applications, or may make the difficult choice of which application to accept.
